SUMMARY:

Dr. Lorne King Rosenfield is a board-certified plastic surgeon in private practice in Burlingame, California, since 1987. He is an active **Clinical Professor** of Plastic Surgery at three renowned Institutions: The University of California, San Francisco, Stanford, and Duke Universities. Dr. Rosenfield has **lectured** widely nationally and internationally and **published** extensively, contributing many original articles and chapters within the plastic surgical literature, including the definitive tome on the subject, Dr. Nahai's *The Art of Aesthetic Surgery*. He has authored innovative contributions in both facial rejuvenation and body contouring, describing procedures that are at once maximally effective and safe. His **"Pinch" Blepharoplasty** and **Facelift** techniques have been universally adopted by his colleagues. Dr. Rosenfield also has written original work on the subject of safety, and his **Perioperative Surgical Checklist** has become the standard for both the American Society of Aesthetic Surgery and within the European Union. He has also been a pioneer as the **first plastic surgeon** to prove the value of **surgical video** for both augmented teaching and self-evaluation, originally harnessing Google Glass and now a headlight-mounted iPhone.

Dr. Rosenfield created and recently just launched a new and innovative aesthetic surgery conference called **The Indie Aesthetic Surgery Summit** in collaboration with Duke University. The express mission of this unique meeting is to promote demystified, unadulterated, practical teaching for the surgeon so that the patient can enjoy the most reliable and maximally safe outcome.

Dr. Rosenfield is presently working on two **books**, *What Would Hippocrates Do?*, which will explore the philosophical origins of Medicine and how these same tenets could better inform our delivery of health care today, and *The Surgical Learning Curve*, which will elucidate his novel approach to both the learning and teaching of aesthetic surgery through the exposure of one's "learning curve" including those of the world's masters of aesthetic surgery.

Dr. Rosenfield is a former **Visiting Lecturer Professor** for both the American

Society of Aesthetic Surgery (ASAPS) and the International Society of Aesthetic Surgery (ISAPS). He is a former **Chair** of the **Patient Safety Committee** and **Teaching Course Committee** at ASAPS and now a **Director** on its Board. Dr. Rosenfield is both a **Senior Examiner** and an elected **Committee Member** of the cosmetic surgery subcommittee at the American Board of Plastic Surgery (ABPS). He has been active in aesthetic surgical education as a **Professor** at UCSF and Stanford and, most recently, Duke University. Dr. Rosenfield serves as a **Board Member** and a section editor of the Aesthetic Surgery Journal (ASJ), the most prestigious in its class. He remains a long-standing **Expert Consultant** for the Medical Board of California, an **Inspector** and past committee member for the American Association for Accreditation of Ambulatory Surgery Facilities (AAAASF), and a committee member of the Patient Safety Committee of both ASAPS and the International Society of Aesthetic Surgery (ISAPS).

Dr. Rosenfield is the **Founder and Director** of the Peninsula Plastic Surgery Foundation, which delivers charity reconstructive surgery to the uninsured within his community, and a former Chairman of the Board of Operation Access, a non-profit organization that coordinates this charitable reconstructive care.
